Gerry Hernandez, a Partnership Specialist, for the U.S. Census Bureau has been visiting organizations in our region to tell people about the upcoming 2020 Census. I heard him speak at The Chamber of Commerce and Kiwanis Club. Gerry tells the story of how he visited the Health Department in Dakota County. He noticed a big jar on the reception desk. He's seen many of these on counters at gas stations or small supermarkets. Usually, the jar is there to collect money in order to help a family cover a medical expense.

Gerry asked who the jar was for, and they replied "The jar is for us—to help the department run". He asked, "Aren't you funded through government support?" They replied, "Yes, but our support is based on the last census data. The support allows us to cover 5,000 people, but there are actually 10,000."

The story is just one example of how important it is for all people to be counted in the upcoming census. Gerry said that some people might complain that the Census Bureau didn't get a good count, but the fact is that the responsibility for getting an accurate count is on each community. He added that children are the most undercounted group.

Gerry seeks community partners to help get an accurate count. In Norfolk, partners include Northeast Community College, Norfolk Chamber of Commerce, and the Norfolk Library.

The Census is also hiring census takers, people who work part-time to follow up with those who have not turned in their census form. Most of this work would be done after April 1, the official census day.

I asked Gerry how churches might support an accurate count. He replied that it can be as simple as getting the word out and sharing the census link (above). He said that teachers often make great census takers because "they often have summers off, and they are a friendly face in town".

I encourage you to go to the link above to learn more about how census data are being used all around you, how your privacy is protected, how you will be able to respond online, and how you can help our community be counted.

In the census, everyone counts. Even Jesus was counted.










Book club meets January 8. Please see Jane Uzzell for the book of the month.
