
### **Annual Gathering Report**

Doane University provided hospitality and a beautiful setting for the Annual Gathering, June 9-10. Church Rep, Ben Uzzell, and I attended. The Nebraska Conference honored Susan Allyn for her 10 years of service on the Board of Directors, and we voted on a new slate of officers. Conference Minister, Rev. Roddy Dunkerson, shared his impressions of the state of the Nebraska Conference as well as a progress report on the new Tri-Conference (includes SD, IA & NE). The way the UCC in these states is joining together to provide Conference support and staffing models is new, so other Conferences are watching our Tri-Conference activities for ideas. Roddy reminded the church that we are pioneers, so we may have "some well watched toe-stubbing incidents along the way". He added, "our deep commitments and our resilience will be a gift that help us adjust and try again." He expects that we will vote on a new Executive Minister (EM) of the Tri-Conference the first Saturday of October. Once the EM has been hired, that person will help to decide where the new offices will be.

Carla Patterson, a bi-vocational pastor at Zion UCC in Talmage presented "a second look at small church ministry, it's power and potential". She encouraged a new look at previously held images of 'church vitality' suggesting that small churches are uniquely equipped to bring a new vision to ministry. I will share some of her insights in the coming weeks.

George Theitje, the Nebraska Rep for the UCC Insurance Board presented implications of changing norms in our society that present changing risk for churches. For example: deciding to be a 'sanctuary church for immigrants', safety plan to respond to an active shooter, privacy concerns for posting prayer lists, legal stances on personnel matters, Work Comp, and who responds if someone falls in our church (Medicare for older members or our church insurance.

As this was Roddy's last Annual Gathering before her retires in December, the Board roasted him and we all thanked him for his years of service. Rev. John Dorhauer, General Minister of the UCC, keynoted and led worship in the afternoon. On Sunday, we were free to worship at other churches. I returned to Friends Meeting (Quakers) in Lincoln; always a meaningful and memorable experience of the Spirit. --Pastor Jackie


