



We met our fundraising goals for the mission trip to Re-Member at Pine Ridge Reservation 7/8 – 7/14, including mission trip insurance.

We'll sell shares through July to add to the guests at the shareholders' dinner Sunday, July 23, and to help cover a few miscellaneous items, such as postcards/postage from the Badlands, a packed lunch for 8 on departure day June 8, fee to enter the Badlands National Park, and any extra fuel costs.

 - 300 Shareholders' Dinner (food)
 - 115 Fuel for 2 cars (estimated)
 - 100 Mission Trip Insurance for all
- 4, 915 Total (\$2250 Participants/\$2695 Raised)


