Ben D. Anderson has visited many churches as Commissioned minister of disabilities education and advocacy in the United Church of Christ.

Ben was born with cerebral palsy in 1953. His first word was 'Moo' (his family lived on a farm). In 1972, Ben graduated from Minot High, Minot, ND. In 1992, he graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Stout, Menomonie, Wisconsin with a B.S. Degree in Vocational Rehabilitation. He lives in South Dakota.

He is the author of *IQ of 63, So What, Going Beyond Everybody Else's Expectations,* and a booklet on bullying titled, *Last One Picked, So What! We Can Turn It Around,* and *If I Can Do It, So Can You!" Going to College.* Ben had to cancel *last fall; we are delighted he will join us.*


