Loving Is Who We Are Joint Annual Meeting 2022, October 9-11, Sioux City, IA

Five years ago, our three conferences voted to join as a "Tri-Conference" to share work and resources. This was a new experiment within the United Church of Christ. Shortly after, in Nebraska, Rev. Roddy Dunkerson retired leaving a big gap of about a year plus before Rev. Darrell Goodwin served Nebraska churches for a couple years before moving to SE New England.

Meanwhile, Covid-19 happened which restricted travel of the Conference staff, and we and other local churches didn't have much of a chance to meet the new staff in person. Over that period, I began to feel more disconnected from the wider church. I continued giving to Our Churches Wider Mission (OCWM), but I wondered:

How will the covenant between local churches and the wider church last, if we don't see faces or get to know those serving the wider church?

These recent changes have helped me to reconnect and have given me hope for our IA, NE, SD Conferences:

- Rev. Sarah Rentzel Jones (Omaha) September visit to our church;
- The Conference inviting our church to share a video at the meeting (created by Sara Putters with help from FCUCC and Linaje Escogido);
- The hiring of Rev. Phil Hart as Executive Minister (He did a good job as Interim to the Illinois Conference when I served in Moline);
- Reconnecting with friends and meeting new ones at the in-person meeting in Sioux City in October;
- A well-organized meeting with good speakers and worship.

At opening ceremonies, we were asked, "What is your hope for the joint gathering?" Mine was to feel reconnected to my wider church. God answered my prayer, and I'm grateful for the clergy and lay-leaders who also participated in the annual gathering.

In addition, the Conferences of IA, NE, and SD are suffering financially. As the treasurer was out sick, Phil Hart was asked to report on the financial state of the Conferences. He has only been serving for 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ months, but he was clear that if the Conferences continued to draw \$40,000/year from savings, we would be bankrupt in 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ years. Hard news. The Conferences were growing, giving from churches was going down, and for several years, this has been the practice.

No more. The problem is now in the light of day. Phil and the Board recommended that we vote on the budget for 3 months, and then return to the 2018 budget. This will mean changes in conference staff and restructuring. The good news is that the Associate Conference Ministers will go back to the previous model of serving the state where they reside.

Please pray for Phil, Sarah and all our IA, NE and SD staff that God guide us as we move through a tough challenge. I thank God, for the new staff we have, and will do what I can to support them, and I ask the church to do the same, because "love is who we are". —Peace, Pastor Jackie


