Natural Disasters

Last month, as newscasters tracked Hurricane Florence through the Southeast, I wondered how my friend's coastal house built on stilts in Oriental, North Carolina would fair. Jim lives in Ohio part of the year, so I knew he and his family were safe. He reported that he had lost a kitchen door, many shingles and some fencing. Thanks to the stilts, the house survived the storm well. A Facebook photo shows his house, a little worse for wear.

Last weekend, other friends coaxed their dogs into the basement as a tornado passed over their home near Northfield, Minnesota. Nancy wrote that she wished they would have practiced with the dogs *beforehand*, but they were all safe—including the horses. It took several days, and many friends with chainsaws to remove so many damaged trees. The electric company trucks arrived three days later to restore power after Bill and Nancy had purchased a generator. Now they are out seeing which neighbors need help, or a generator.

Natural disasters take many forms: hurricanes, floods, tornados, wild fires, volcanic eruptions, earthquakes and tsunamis, blizzards and droughts. Such events become 'disasters' when they affect a vulnerable population. A natural disaster can cause the loss of life, or property damage, as well as economic damage in its wake.

When disaster strikes, we may not have a chainsaw ready or a generator to lend, but we can help others. The United Church of Christ reaches out with money and disaster recovery volunteers to help people rebuild their physical homes, and act to be a presence and walk beside people as they seek to rebuild their lives. *UCC Disaster Ministries* serve with others to be the body of Christ in the world. They arrange opportunities for mission groups to help homeowners in the intermediate and long-term recovery process.




