#### Lent

**Dates:** Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, which falls 40 days before Easter. Sundays aren't counted because Sundays are considered "little Easters", meaning we celebrate resurrection throughout the year.

Ash Wednesday: Is a special feast day that starts the Lent/Easter season. Wearing ashes is considered a sign of repentance, sorrow and mourning, an appropriate way to begin Lent.


**Meaning:** The Lenten journey from the ashes of death to resurrected life begins on the first day of Lent, Ash Wednesday. The start signifies a time to turn around, to change direction, to repent. The first day of Lent reminds us that unless we are willing to die to our old selves, we can't be raised to new life with Christ. The first step calls us to confession.

During the placing of ashes on one's forehead, these words are often spoken: "You are dust, and to dust you shall return." The ashes remind us that we are finite creatures. Ashes also symbolize the broken debris of our lives, and a reminder that each of us will die.

Trusting in Christ's resurrection helps us listen for the word of God in the time-honored stories of the Church's Lenten journey. What sense does Christ's resurrection make if we don't acknowledge his death? What sense does our own resurrection make (or that of our loved one's) if we don't acknowledge the weight we feel around the topic of death. Living in a culture that would rather deny death gives more importance to our participating in this season.

How to participate: Ways to participate might include attending worship throughout the season. Ash Wednesday service is a good start. This year Trinity Episcopal Church will host an early 5:30 service where you may receive the ashes and share in communion. I also invite you to consider a daily meditation of some kind. Take a few minutes perhaps in the morning or evening for prayer. You may pick up a devotional booklet at the church either *These Days* or *The Upper Room*; or visit *The Upper Room Daily Devotions* online at: <a href="https://www.upperroom.org/devotionals">https://www.upperroom.org/devotionals</a>. I like the art on their website, too. Add something or remove something from your routine to help you remember that you journey with Jesus to the cross.




manipulated on the computer. You might click 'Like' at Nebraska Through the Lens' if you are on Facebook as a devotional for Lent. There is always something inspirational there.
